Free or Subsidized Facility Use Guidelines (sp)

The Oliver Parks and Recreation Society is supportive of the many contributions that various non-profit organizations make to maintain and enhance the lifestyle of the community. Organizations wishing to apply for rental exemption or a rental subsidy for use of the Community Hall must comply with the following guidelines. The use of other Parks and Recreation facilities would also be taken under consideration. Organizations should be aware that applications where admission is charged or alcohol is served will not be considered.

1. All organizations must provide detailed information on the accompanying application form.
2. The event must be non-profit in nature and contribute to the enrichment of the community life or be a service that warrants public support.
3. In general, only volunteer organizations are eligible. Requests will not normally be granted for private parties or events.
4. Applications should be submitted so that the Society has adequate time to consider the request. The final decision will be given within thirty days of the event. (no change to Carolyn's version)
5. In general, only one request per organization will be considered per year.
6. Successful applicants must report in writing to the Society providing details as to the success of the event. Failure to do so may jeopardize any future applications.
7. Successful applicants will be required to sign a rental agreement and comply with all conditions therein.

The Society reserves the right to refuse any application should it deem the event not to be in the best interest of the community.
